## SEND YOUR MUSIC TO THE RECORD EXCHANGE BEFORE TREEFORT, THEN PICK UP ANY UNSOLD ITEMS ON YOUR WAY OUT OF TOWN!

<u>The Record Exchange</u>, Boise's largest independent record store, is looking for Treefort artists to send their music prior to the festival so they can have it on the shelves leading up to and during the fest.

The store (located on the corner of 11th and Idaho streets next to Treefort venue Neurolux) will sell your music on consignment, then settle up with you on your way out of town. Artists have the option of picking up any unsold merchandise (along with a check or Venmo payment for any sales) or leaving it at the store. (Note: Per store policy, The Record Exchange does not buy music from out-of-state, unsigned bands; if you'd like to leave it there and keep your music on the shelves after the festival, you would essentially be leaving it for free, then they would send you payment for any sales and possibly request more product if it's selling.)

They are looking for vinyl, CDs and cassettes with a **suggested quantity of 5 or less units** (combined formats) per title, with a heavy emphasis on vinyl and cassettes, which tend to sell better during Treefort than CDs. Please do not send any non-music merch such as clothing or posters. They will, however, accept promotional posters for display or free hand-out items (stickers, etc.) to place on the counters.

If you want to send the store music, please include a printed sheet with the following:

- Titles of releases
- Quantities for each title by format (they will double check quantities upon receipt and contact you if there are any discrepancies)
- Contact info for band tour manager/representative, including cell and email
- Mailing address and official business name or Venmo handle for payment processing
- Suggested retail price for each item (please keep this consistent with your pricing for merch tables at shows)

Note: The Record Exchange will deduct its standard consignment percentage (30%) from sales and pay you for the other 70%.
